

INSCRIPTION OPENING NOTICE DIRECT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM INCOMING STUDENT -

UNIVERSIDADE PAULISTA – UNIP

Universidade Paulista - UNIP will select undergraduate students from partner universities in Latin America and Europe to undertake our international exchange program.

The interchange period will last one term, being from February to end of June or from August to mid of December.

Areas covered by the Undergraduate Program: Architecture, Accounting, Biomedicine, Business Administration, Dentistry, Economics, Engineering, Human Resources Management, International Relations, Law, Nursing, Pharmaceutical sciences, Psychology, Physical Education, Physiotherapy and Tourism.

The scholarship does **NOT** include airfare ticket, health insurance, accommodation, meals and ground transportation.

The classes will be taught in Brazilian Portuguese.

Application deadline:

1st semester (february - june): november 30th 2nd semester (august – december): may 30th

The selection will follow the procedures below:

1.REGISTRATION.

The student who fulfills the following conditions can apply in the selection for the Direct Scholarship Program:

- a) To be regularly enrolled in one of the undergraduate courses of our partner universities in Latin America and Europe during the entire selection process and must keep bound to the home university as long as the program lasts.
- b) To present a general average of **7.0** or higher or **A** or B (or equivalent) in the subjects studied in the Undergraduate Program of origin.
- c) Not be Brazilian, not even those living abroad.
- d) Have a valid passport by the time of registration.



2. APPLICATION

The International Relations Office from partner university must send an e-mail to the Academic Internationalization at UNIP (<u>internacionalizacaoacademica1@unip.br</u>), with a copy to <u>internacionalizacaoacademica2@unip.br</u>), having as subject DIRECT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, providing the following documents in PDF format:

- Application form UNIP duly fulfilled, printed and signed, including a recent 3x4 photo (Attached I).
- Updated transcript.
- Copy of passport.
- Recommendation letter from home university.
- UNIP's Term of Acceptance fulfilled and signed (Attached II).

Application deadline:

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1<sup>st</sup> semester (february - june): 30<sup>th</sup> november 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (august – december): 30<sup>th</sup> may
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3. SELECTION CRITERIA.

a) Step 1

- Analysis of the documents requested in this public notice;
- Analysis of school records,
- Analysis of the eligibility to the Direct Scholarship Program.

Note 1: Only the inscription sent from the International Relations Office directly to the e-mail internacionalizacaoacademica1@unip.br, with a copy to internacionalizacaoacademica2@unip.br, containing **all** requested information duly fulfilled, accompanied by all documents in PDF format will be analyzed.

Candidates who do not submit ALL documents requested will have their applications automatically INDEFERRED.

Note 2: Inscriptions sent by mail will not be accepted.

Note 3: Candidates must enable their email boxes to receive messages from the addresses internacionalizacaoacademica2@unip.br, and internacionalizacaoacademica2@unip.br during all selection process.
